A Message from the Chairman of the Welsh Students Rugby Association

The roots of student sport in England and Wales can be traced back to the history of the universities of Oxford and Cambridge. It is recorded that as long ago as 1303, football was being played at Oxford. In the 16th century both Oxford and Cambridge prohibited football on sufferance of a fine of six shillings and eight pence at Cambridge and of twenty shillings and an imprisonment at Oxford.

Student sport as practised that long ago bore little resemblance to modern day sport but even sport as we now know it has existed amongst students for a century and a half. The game of rugby football has long held a great appeal for students due to its physical and skilful nature and the camaraderie which it engenders. There is little evidence to suggest that the game has not been encouraged amongst students. Rather, the opposite is more true—rugby football has been widely supported and developed within institutions of higher learning.

Today's match bears some historic significance. It is the first time for the Welsh Students Association to play against a full national side and to find itself on the itinerary of a touring team invited by the Welsh Rugby Union. The Welsh Students Rugby Association is delighted to take part in a game against

Spain.

The W.S.R.A. was established in 1982 (when it played its first game against the English Students) and in 1984 it was granted Associate Membership of the Welsh Rugby Union. With Mr. Hermas Evans as President and Mr. V.L. Price as W.R.U. representative, a small committee including Mr. Rob Llewelyn (Polytechnic of Wales) and Mr. Leighton Davies (South Glamorgan Institute of Higher Education) as coach has been

instrumental in its development.

The W.S.R.A. offers a significant level of representative rugby for young players which comes between the Under 19 (Schools and Youth) and Wales 'B' category. The Welsh Students side is selected from those studying at Universities, Colleges and Institutes of Education, the Polytechnics in Wales, England and elsewhere. The values of such a team are thought to be many. The progress of young players can be evaluated in games of international standing against suitable opposition and the form of Welsh students studying in England and elsewhere can be monitored too.

The Welsh Students side and its attendant recognition create an interest and motivation amongst student clubs. the W.S.R.A. provides opportunities for students to play at a tesing level. The clubs of Wales will ultimately benefit by being fed by young players who have gained valuable experience. Already during its short existence a number of full internationals have come through the Student XV ranks including Robert Ackerman, Mark Wyatt, Mark Titley, Phil Lewis, Terry Shaw and Paul Thorburn, while Geraint John and Ieuan Evans have been chosen for the Wales 'B' team to face Spain later this week.

A sincere welcome is afforded to the Spanish team under its manager Senor Lino Plaza. Grateful thanks are extended to the Welsh Rugby Union and Cardiff R.F.C. for their help in staging tonight's game and to all of you for supporting the match.




