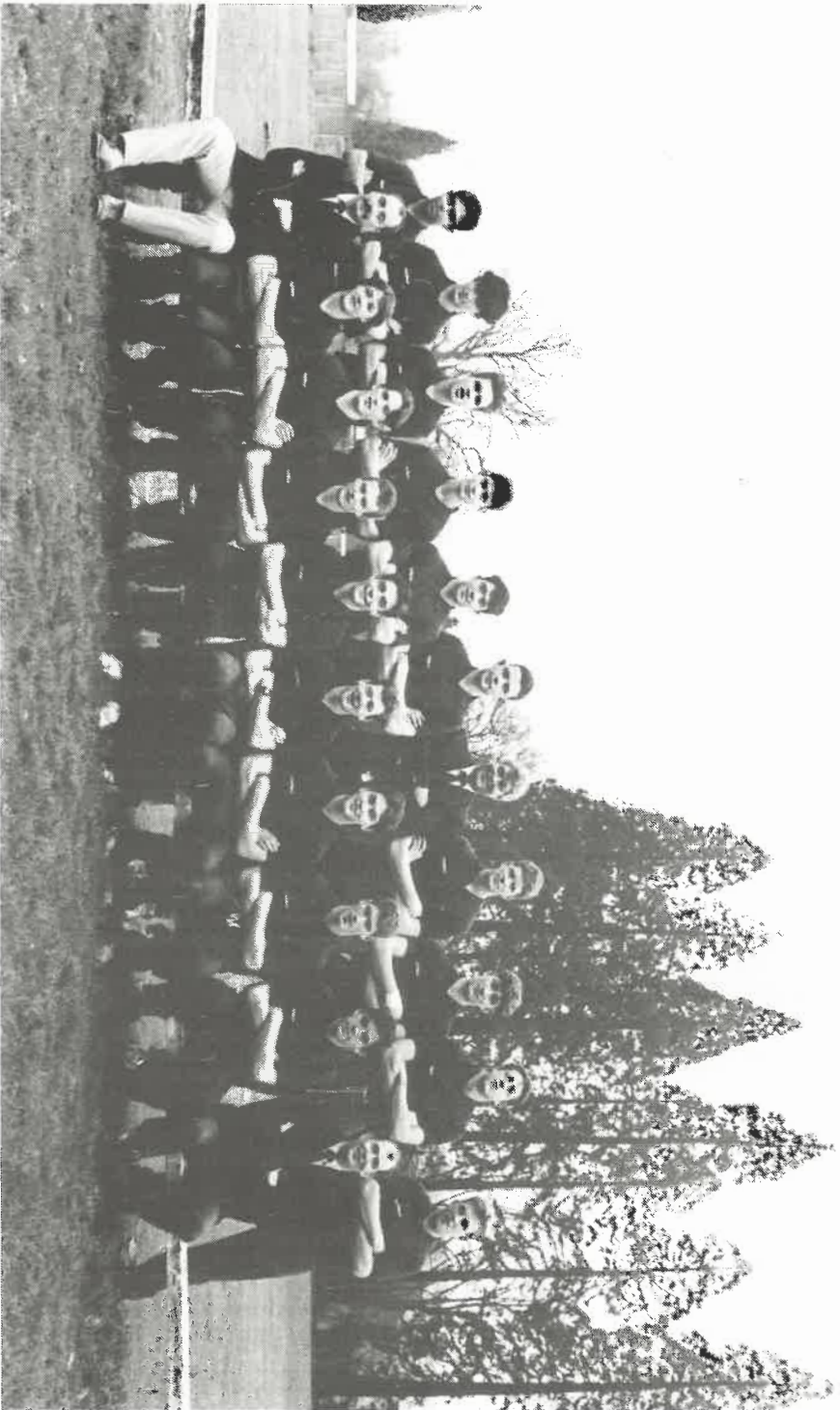
This is Spain's first visit to England at under sixteen. I hope that it is the first of many, that they enjoy their rugby and make many new friends.

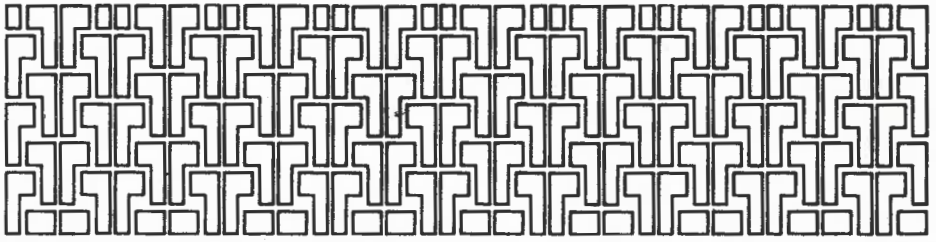

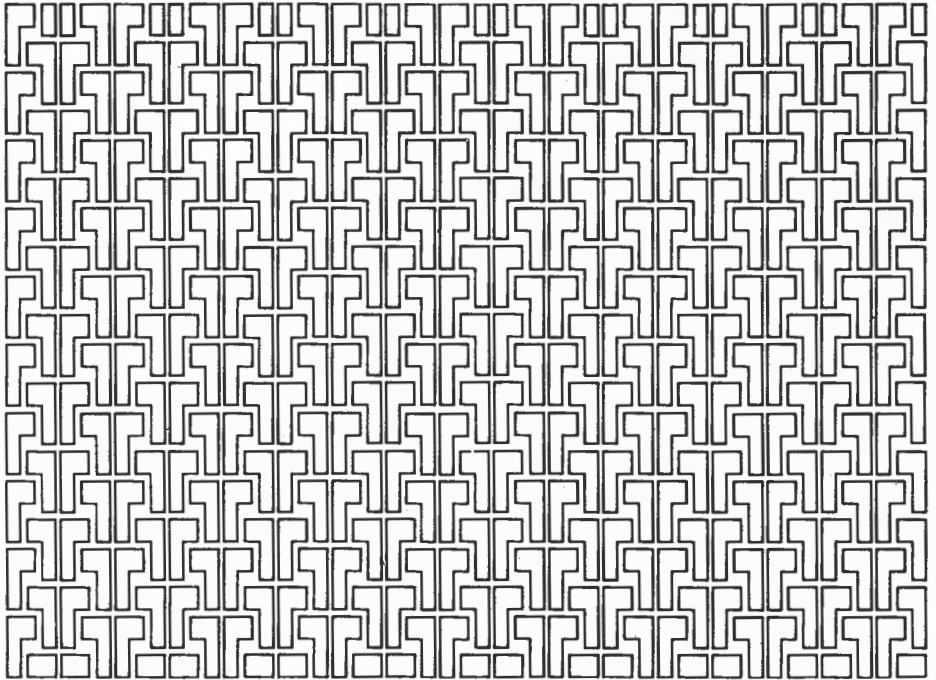

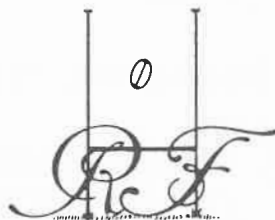
