

The 19's National Team is a vital and integral part of the IRFU's Elite Player Development Programme.

It was initiated to form a vital bridge between our national Schools / Youth teams and our U21's team. As well as providing this bridge, it also caters for the late developer who may not have been capped at Youth or School level.

Established just last year ,this age grade also brings us into line with many of the European playing nations, thereby affording us fixtures such as tonight's and the recent Italian match.

The 19's season culminates with participation in the Junior World Cup - an annual tournament consisting of 32 nations, held over a 10 day period. Last year it took place in Argentina where Ireland, entering for the first time finished in a a creditable fourth place following there Semi-final defeat to the eventual winners Argentina.

This year the tournament is being held in Toulouse ,where Ireland are pooled with South Africa , USA, and Poland.

I cannot over stress the benefits that entering this competition has and will have for Irish rugby, by allowing our potential future internationals to be exposed to so many varying styles of play over such a short time span, will in itself bring its own reward. However, the cultural benefits afforded these young men of Ireland in having the opportunity to mix with the many and varied cultures of the world will contribute to their personal development and growth.

I take this opportunity to welcome Spain's National 19's group to Ireland for this fixture which I envisage to be the start of a long and lasting relationship at this level.

May I also take the opportunity to thank Bangor Rugby Club and the many volunteers involved in creating what I am sure will be a memorable night for all.
